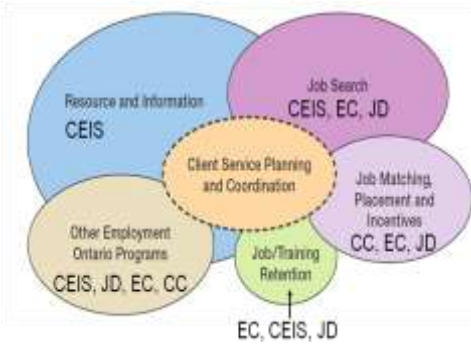

CEIS - Career and Employment Information Specialist Training



Under the new guidelines provided by Employment Ontario, a key component is **Client Service Planning and Coordination (CSPC)**. Within CSPC, an important element is the ability of an agency to:

"provide information on local training and employment opportunities, community service supports, occupational and training requirements and resources to support independent or "unassisted" job search, career clarification and planning, and informed education, training and employment decisions."

This course, based on the Forum of Labour Market Ministers' (FLMM) Career and Labour Market Information Service Delivery Guidelines, will provide critical professional development to staff and assist them in guiding clients in the right direction by helping them make better informed career decisions

- Create an environment that promotes successful "unassisted" career planning, informed training and education decisions, and job search.
- Become familiar with the wide variety of career, employment and labour market resources.

- Use practical techniques for ordering, cataloguing and tracking resources.
- Keep up-to-date with the latest career and employment information and resources.
- Promote and market the information service.
